

# JoJo Knits

## Cabled Fingerless Mitts

The Cabled Fingerless Mitts pictured here were knit in Plymouth Yarn's Galway worsted weight yarn color #179 (a goldenrod yellow). They are sized for adults and are worked flat. The thumb gusset is made by picking up stitches along the seamed edge.

### Materials

- 1 skein Plymouth Yarn "Galway"
- Needles- Size 6 (4mm) and Size 8 (5mm) straight or circular and one set (4) size 8 (5mm) double points (or size needed to obtain gauge)
- Cable needle
- Yarn needle for finishing

### Measurements

- Women's Hand Circumference/Length 7/8 inches
- Men's Hand Circumference/Length 8/9 ½ inches

### Gauge

19 stitches (sts) and 25 rows to 4 inches over Stockinette stitch (St st) on larger needles

### Glossary:

- **6 Stitch Left Cross (LC) Cable**  
Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, K3, then 3 from cable needle

### Mitt

Using smaller needles CO 35 (41) sts. Beginning with p1, work in k1, p1 rib for 9 rows.

Change to larger needles. Next Row (RS): (k1, p1) 2 (3) times and then increase 15 (15) sts evenly across the middle 27 (29) sts, (p1, k1) 2 (3) times 50 (56) sts.

Next Row (WS) Cable set up row: (p1, k1) 2 (3) times, (p6, k1) 2 (2) times, p6, k1 (2), p1, k1 (2), (p6, k1) 2 times, p6, (k1, p1) 2 (3) times



### Begin Cable pattern

Rows 1 and 2: knit sts as presented (knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts)

Row 3 (RS) (k1, p1) 2 (3) times, (LC, p1) 2 (2) times, LC, p1 (2), k1, p1 (2), (LC, p1) 2 (2) times, LC (p1, k1) 2 (3) times

Rows 4, 5 and 6: knit sts as presented.

Row 7 (RS) (k1, p1) 2 (3) times, k6, p1, LC, p1, k6, p1 (2), k1, p1 (2), k6, p1, LC, p1, k6, (p1, k1) 2 (3) times

Rows 8, 9 and 10: knit sts as presented

Repeat rows 3 through 10, 3 (4) times.

Repeat rows 3, 4 and 5 once more. Next Row, (WS), (p1, k1) 2 (3) times then using p2tog, decrease 15 (15) sts evenly across the middle 42 (50) sts, (k1, p1) 2 (3) times 35 (41) sts.

Change to smaller needles. Next row (RS) work in k1, p1 rib for 9 rows, or 1 ½ inches. Bind off all sts in rib pattern.

### Finishing and Thumb gusset

Beginning at the cast on edge sew sides of mitt together to thumb opening 4 ¼ (4 ¾) inches. Seam from the top of the mitt down 2 ¼ (2 ¾) inches. With right side facing and using double point needles, pick up and knit 6 (7) sts up one side, 1 (1) st in seam edge, 6 (7) sts down other side and 1 (1) st in other seam edge 14 (16) sts. Join for working in the round and knit 9 (9) rows. Bind off all sts knitwise.
